- **Vital Statistics**
 - ◆ Five floors (One floor for growth)
 - ◆ 259,580 square feet
 - ◆ 24-hour maternity ambulance entrance
 - ◆ 140 licensed beds
 - ◆ 23 labor and delivery suites
 - ◆ 48 mother/baby rooms with a well-baby nursery
 - ◆ 37 medical-surgical rooms
 - ◆ Six intensive care rooms and 12 high-risk antepartum rooms
 - ◆ Eight surgery suites, with room for growth
 - ◆ Nine obstetrical assessment private rooms
 - ◆ 40-bed newborn intensive care unit
 - ◆ 540 physicians
 - ◆ 330 nursing staff professionals/600 total employees
- **Cost**
 - ◆ Approximately \$71 million
 - ◆ Approximately \$167 per square foot
- **Special Features**
 - ◆ 80,000-square-foot adjoining physicians' office building
 - ◆ 670-space adjoining parking garage and 300 surface parking spaces
 - ◆ Seismically structured to meet current earthquake codes for this region
 - ◆ Pantry kitchens on two patient floors
 - ◆ Two sleep rooms for parents of babies in the newborn intensive care unit
 - ◆ 10 physician sleep rooms
 - ◆ Urodynamics Lab, incontinence services & physical therapy
 - ◆ Dr. Sam P. Patterson Library, open to the community and physicians
 - ◆ Pathway to Prayer Garden dedicated in 2005. The garden offers patients, families, employees and the community a quiet place for meditation.
