

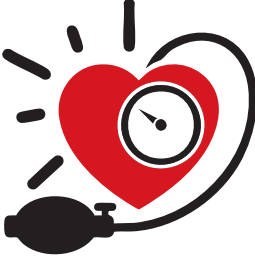
MEDICATION EDUCATION

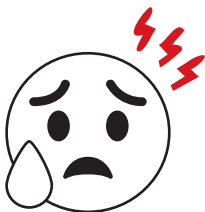
Welcome to Baptist Anderson Regional Medical Center!

High Blood Pressure (BP) and / or Heart 	• Lisinopril (Prinivil, Zestril) • Losartan (Cozaar) • Valsartan (Diovan) • Olmesartan (Benicar) • Amlodipine (Norvasc) • Diltiazem (Cardizem) • Atenolol (Tenormin) • Carvedilol (Coreg) • Metoprolol tartrate (Lopressor) • Metoprolol succinate (Toprol XL) • Furosemide (Lasix) • Hydrochlorothiazide (Microzide) • Spironolactone (Aldactone)	Symptoms of lowered blood pressure (BP): Feeling Dizzy Headache Symptoms of lowered BP Feeling sleepy or tired Feel weak Symptoms of lowered BP Frequent urination
High Cholesterol 	• Atorvastatin (Lipitor) • Pravastatin (Pravachol) • Rosuvastatin (Crestor)	Joint pain Muscle aches
Type 2 diabetes 	• Metformin (Glucophage)	Diarrhea Gas / stomach pain Upset stomach or throwing up
Type 1 Or Type 2 diabetes (insulin) 	• Short acting or meal time • Insulin lispro (Humalog) • Long acting • Insulin glargine (Lantus)	Symptoms of low blood sugar: Headache Hunger Shakiness Sweating Weakness
Blood Thinners 	• Apixaban (Eliquis) • Aspirin • Clopidogrel (Plavix) • Heparin • Enoxaparin (Lovenox) • Rivaroxaban (Xarelto) • Ticagrelor (Brilinta) • Warfarin (Coumadin, Jantoven)	Risk of bleeding / bruising Upset stomach
