PD's Perch is an infusion and outpatient diagnostic testing center for patients 0-17. The Perch has a private waiting area with trained nurses who can prepare your child for any of the following procedures:

- Lab tests
- Foley catheters
- IV fluids
- Blood administration
- Antibiotic infusions
- Diagnostic X-rays
- CTs and MRI testing with and without anesthesia
- Ultrasounds
- EKG
- Fluoroscopy

You and your pediatrician and/or health care provider may also elect to have the following pediatric surgeries:

- Ear, nose, and throat
- Ophthalmology

- OrthopedicPlastic
- General surgery
- Gastroenterology
- Gynecological
